





1. A candidate can apply for a post of the Departmental Society/ Staff Council Society as per the eligibility defined under the rules passed by the Staff Council dated 25th April, 2017.
2. The Posts are: a) Student Coordinator (Only from Third Year Students); b) Deputy Coordinator (Only from Second Year Students); c) Treasurer (Only from First year Students); and d) Five Executive Members (open to students of any year)
3. The selection process is based on TWO criterias: 1. Merit and 2. Interview/presentation. The details are shown on the next page.
4. Since the selection to a post is based on merit-cum-interview the result once declared cannot be challenged under any circumstances.
5. A Student shall not be allowed to apply for more than two committees/societies (one academic & one Staff Council Committee/Society). However, a Student shall be allowed to hold post of one committee/society only.

After receiving the duly filled application forms the dept. will short list the candidate and define the score on merit head on the basis of the percentage of marks obtained in the last exam passed by the applicants as well as the score on attendance (already defined as above). The final merit list shall be based on the composite total scores which will determine the selection of the candidate to a particular post. The No 1 in the merit list shall be declared **SELECTED** to a particular post he/she has applied for. The decision of the Selection Committee of the Dept./Committee/Society shall be final and binding to all.
