This is a cause for celebration, but this growth also presents challenges in the form of rising consumption and demand for energy, increasing greenhouse gas emissions, and constraints on critical natural resources such as land, water and biodiversity harboured by them. Confronting today's environmental challenges requires cooperation and commitment from all sectors of society.

Sustainable development is a key concept that provides an answer to the question how humankind coexists harmoniously with the earth and with nature. Keeping this in mind, the Eco Club (The Environmental Society), Satyawati College Evening, University of Delhi in association with Department of Environment, Government of NCT Delhi proposes to hold a one day national seminar on November 15, 2017 to address issues and challenges of sustainable development in the era of fast changing environment.
