NOTICE

Creation of Cluster Colleges (Knowledge Networks)

1. The University of Delhi is implementing the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP) through the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework 2022 (UGCF). Providing flexibility to students to choose the courses according to their interest and future prospects is one of the founding principles of NEP. With a view to provide such flexibility it is imperative for Colleges and Departments imparting UG programs to provide several options/choices to the students. However, the range of choices of courses that may be offered by a College largely depends upon the availability of faculties to teach such courses as well as other attendant infrastructural and functional requirements. Colleges shall share their resources, to the extent possible, with other Colleges, located in its vicinity, so as to provide more choices to students and overcome the resource constrains/limitations at the end of each College.
2. Colleges of the University of Delhi shall be grouped under five different Cluster Colleges depending upon their geographical locations. The suggested Cluster Colleges are enclosed in the Annexure-1. The role and function of Cluster Colleges are stated below.
 - 2.1. Each Cluster Colleges shall operate as Knowledge Network.
 - 2.2. The College, highlighted within a cluster, has been identified as the Nodal/Hub College, which will act as the nodal point for coordination with the University as well as the Colleges within the said cluster for smooth implementation of the NEP. The Nodal/Hub college shall coordinate with the rest of the colleges in the cluster for effective and smooth networking for sharing of resources, particularly for providing more options for SEC, VAC and AEC courses, in the interest of the students. Out of the five clusters, four will also have Co-Hub College (underlined> for effective coordination.
 - 2.3. There shall be one Nodal Faculty in each college to coordinate with the Nodal/Hub College in a Cluster/Knowledge Network.
 - 2.4. The Coordinators of Nodal/Hub College and Co-Hub College) shall coordinate with the Nodal Faculties in the Cluster/ Knowledge Network to constitute three working groups, namely
 - 2.4.1. Skill Enhancement Courses Working Group
 - 2.4.2. Value Addition Courses Working Group
 - 2.4.3. Ability Enhancement Courses Working GroupMore working groups may be created as per requirement.
3. The Hub Colleges and Co-Hub Colleges for the five Clusters are as follows:
 - i) North Cluster Colleges – Daulat Ram College -Hub & Hans Raj College – Co-Hub
 - ii) Central Cluster Colleges – Janki Devi Memorial College (Hub) & Zakir Hussain College (Day) – Co-Hub
 - iii) East Cluster Colleges – Shyamlal College (Day) – Hub (the cluster being small, no Co-Hub college is proposed)
 - iv) West Cluster College – Shaheed Shukhdev College of Business Studies- Hub & Shri Gurugovind Singh College of Commerce – Co-Hub
 - v) South Cluster Colleges – Sri Venkateswara College – Hub & Deshbandu College – Co-Hub
