1. A student can apply for a post of the Departmental Society/Staff Council Society as per the eligibility defined under the rules passed by the Staff Council dated 25th April, 2017.
2. The Posts are: a) Student Coordinator (Only from Third Year Students); b) Deputy Student Coordinator (Only from Second Year Students); c) Treasurer (Only from First year Students); and d) Five Executive Members (open to students of any year)
3. The selection process is based on TWO criterias: 1. Merit and 2. Interview/presentation. The details are shown on the next page.
4. Since the selection to a post is based on merit-cum-interview the result once declared cannot be challenged under any circumstances.
5. A Student shall not be allowed to apply for more than two committees/societies (one academic & one Staff Council Committee/Society). However, a Student shall be allowed to hold post of one committee/society only.
6. If candidate has occupied offices (except the post of executive) of President, Vice President, Joint Secretary, and Treasurer of any society or committee in any last academic session/s, he/she shall not be reselected for any of the post of Coordinator, Deputy Coordinator and Treasurer in the current academic session.
